

6 out of 10 Former students (or their parents) were able to be contacted and completed interviews

24% of Former Students reported that they were currently enrolled at a 2-4 year College/University

47% of Former Students reported that they were Currently Employed  
Of those who are employed, 2 of 3 state that they like their job

77% of Former Students reported being either “Happy” or “Very Happy” with their lives
