Why?

Who?

Former students who had an Individualized Education Program (IEP) during their last year of high school and who are no longer enrolled in high school will be asked to participate in the interview. Responding is voluntary and confidential.

How?

One year after you have left school, you will be contacted by someone from your school and asked a few questions. An example question might be:

- ◆ Are you currently working for pay?
- ◆ Would you like to work more than you currently are?
- ◆ Are you in any type of school or training program now?
- ◆ How happy are you with your life right now?
