Who?

You will be asked to participate in the Youth One Year Out (YOYO) interview if you had an Individualized Education Program (IEP) in place at the time you exited high school.

What?

The Youth One Year Out (YOYO) former student interview was developed by the Kentucky Post School Outcomes Center (KYPSO). The interviewer will gather information from you such as:

- Are you currently working for pay?
- Are you in any type of school or training program now?
- How have things been going for you since you left school?

When?

You will be asked to participate in the Youth One Year Out (YOYO) interview one year after exiting high school. The interviews usually take place between April and August. Responding to the interview is voluntary and confidential.

Why?

During the interview you will have a chance to describe your experiences and learn about resources. This information will be used to help future students be more successful after high school and be better prepared for college or work. It is also a federal and state requirement for schools to conduct these interviews.

How?

One year after exiting high school, you will be contacted by someone from your school and asked a few questions. You may receive a reminder letter in the mail before the interview begins. Make sure your school has your updated contact information such as mailing address, phone number, and email address.
