




Ensure education matches individual aspirations and objectives.




Legal Protections

Flexible schedules for diverse learning opportunities.




4-Year Colleges

On-campus jobs provide valuable earning opportunities




State & Local Financial Aid Options


ABLE Accounts

Preparing for College


Academic Readiness

Goal-Setting


Create clear academic and career pathway goals.

Talk early with disability services for support








